Vibro-Meter Installs the Engine Vibration Monitoring System EVM-249 on the AN-140 Aircraft

Vibro-Meter recently received from the Aviation Register of Interstate Aviation Committee (Certification Authority of the Commonwealth of Independent States) an Approval Letter. This Letter indicates that Vibro-Meter is certified to install the Engine Vibration Monitoring System EVM-249 on the AN-140 aircraft.

The An-140 has been developed by Antonov design bureau, based in the Ukraine. It is a 50 seat turboprop regional aircraft powered by two turboprop engines TV3-117VMA-SBM1. The latter were developed by the engine design bureau ZMKB "Progress" and manufactured by the engine manufacturer "Motor Sich", both companies are also based in the Ukraine.

Our contract covers the delivery of 28 engine shipsets and 3 aircraft shipsets this year. Vibro-Meter has already delivered 17 engine shipsets and 1 aircraft shipset of the equipment so far this year.

The AN-140 is targeted to replace part of approximately 540 AN-24 aircraft that have been in operation in some 30 countries and are phased out due to life limits.

NB: Vibro-Meter also passed successfully the flight evaluation and approval of the Ice Detector Probe EW 164 for the AN-140.
